This would be formed in the fall of 2015. The step writing would be conducted through the mail between NA members within our zonal regions who would sponsor addicts seeking recovery who are currently incarcerated in correctional facilities located within the PSZF regions who want to find a new way to live. The PSZF Regions currently include Best Little (mostly Northwest Texas), Iowa, Mid-America (mostly Kansas), Nebraska, OK (mostly Oklahoma), and South Dakota Regions.
