## **RCM Report:** Committee Member Angie S. minutes and report;

- **RD report:** Cindy reported: Sustainability is being discussed by world. They are cutting back on travel so funding travel to 3 meetings this year instead of 4. This year there are 18 world board members. May end up recommending between 12 & 15 after a few more discussions.
- Traditions Book: First draft is now on-line. Next deadline for new submissions is Dec 31. De & Tim will be presenting at the GSA.
- World will be sending out info on 3 different IP's: "Group Support Basics", "Local Services Basics", & "What is the SSP?"
- Planning our Future met for the 1<sup>st</sup> time via webinar. Cindy is on this workgroup.
- We are being encouraged to read the Intellectual Property Trust (FIPT) bulletin.
- Our region had no input on the guide to world services.
- Zone in Abileen, TX. Travel needed for the RD and RD Alt. Cindy will send flyer for this interested. The multi-zonal service symposium will be there. Requesting input from RCM's by Feb.

Kyle, the RD Alt will bring ideas after attending the Service Symposium in St. Louis. He will also be finding someone from that committee to come and assist with something like this or if they would even be willing (he was pretty certain they would be).
- There was discussion about if our region might be interested in forming a committee to serve in the same capacity as P3 (raising funds for donating NA literature to prisons). There will be workshops on this subject at the Service Symposium in St. Louis so more will be revealed.
- The multi-zonal service symposium had been voted in as a one-time event. A proposal was made at zone to poll all regions on whether we want to continue an ongoing, self-sustaining MZSS. It would require that Regions make another donation for startup costs.
- Cindy the RD will be creating a survey to try to determine the consensus of our region in regard to how
  the future of the World Service Conference. That was evidently a hot topic during the last one she and
  Kyle attended. She remains concerned on how to keep addicts involved in the CAR (Conference Agenda
  Report).
