NA World Service

- A. Conference Participant webinars continue to be held every other month to inform participants of plans for the upcoming World Service Conference, (which will be held, if possible, April 30-May 6, 2023), the future of the World Service Conference and allow discussion between participants. Due to scheduling conflicts, only Pam was able to attend the August Webinar and only Tim will attend the October webinar. We generally both attend each time and always make the effort to do so.
- B. During the August webinar the following World Board recommendations were discussed.
 - 1. Trying a three-year cycle on a trial basis for two cycles until 2029.
 - 2. Holding an interim virtual WSC between in-person meetings to decide on items selected by conference participants.
 - 3. Posting the English CAR six months before the in-person WSC (rather than five).
 - 4. Continuing to try new things with the help of a workgroup of zonally selected members to help frame ideas for discussion.
 - 5. Making participant funding opt-in rather than opt-out. Any delegate who requests total or partial funding will receive it.
- C. Short essays on each of these recommendations can be found, along with other reports regarding the future of the WSC at www.na.org/conference. The World Board does anticipate including motions in the CAR to cover these recommendations.
- D. The English Conference Agenda Report is due out by November 30, 2022, with the translated versions following one month later. Conference Approval Track materials will be available January 30, 2023. The deadline for amendments to CAR and CAT is April 15, 2023. To help move things along and perhaps make better use of time at the WSC, there will be some initial straw polling of delegates as soon as possible after April 15, 2023.
