Our EASC phoneline provides a current list of meetings in the Eastern Area, but what if someone needs something more? We give them the option to speak to a live addict. Our goal is to have this service available 24/7. How do we do that??.....Volunteers!!

## "I am not sure I am 'qualified' to do that...."

Each phoneline volunteer must have at least 6 months clean and complete the phoneline training to be sure we are all on the same page.

Phoneline volunteers choose a time slot each week that they can be available to respond to calls. If your schedule changes, it is simple to update your phoneline commitment.
