*RD Team:* Attended the Interim World Conference. All eleven of the motions covered during the GSA were passed by the Interim WSC. The deadline for the CAR survey is May 20th. July 25th through 27th is the next meeting for PFZF at Sioux Falls, South Dakota. The flyer should be out soon. PFZF will host a CAR workshop December 5-7 near Iowa City, IA. Multizonal Service Symposium will be held Oct 1-4, 2026.
