EASC PR March 2026

Phoneline - running well but can always use support. There is a 6-month clean-time requirement and orientation attendance as well. The orientation can be found online at eascna.org/phoneline.

Website – Our web contact was recently faced with some health issues, but the meeting list update team managed to get the schedule updated. Group and H&I schedules are available.

Metro Racks – no change

PR met with two members of the Tulsa Health Department to see if THD partnered with other agencies on events we might be able to attend with our literature. We were put on the mailing list for such notifications. This may not have been exactly a home run meeting since the staff we spoke with has a wide range of health topics to tend to, but we were invited to attend an online meeting with the local DUI task force. At that meeting there was an EMSA representative who announced a resource fair type event they plan to sponsor for May 16 at the Tulsa Zoo from noon until four. We asked later if NA might be a good fit and were assured we were welcome. We also ran across a second event called Rising Together - Recovery Summit, scheduled on the day before, from about eight to noon, sponsored by Tulsa County Health. Registration has been made.

Annual H&I learning day/Mass orientation is set for May 16th from 130 to 330. We will have speaker, food, and orientation.

New panel started: Haven Detox, every Wednesday

Panels that need support: Payne county jail (men & women), Monarch (men & women), Creek County women, John Lilley.

Motion: EASC PR subcommittee proposes that the Eastern Area Service Committee provide funds from the general fund in the amount not to exceed \$1500 for registration to the Zarrow Mental Health Symposium, to be held October 1 & 2, 2026, in Tulsa.

Intent: To raise awareness that NA is a viable program for recovery, provide NA literature, and respond to questions or comments about our path to recovery during an event for mental health professionals who are likely to have significant contact with addicts, hopefully resulting in an increased number of professionals suggesting that their patients/clients try NA.

Rationale: NA public relations committees generally focus on carrying our message to the public, much as our Hospitals and Institutions committee carries our message to facilities where clients have no access to outside meetings. Our hope is that by attending this and other similar events, we can further our message of recovery. The event is attended by around 800 participants

Since the February EASC meeting was cancelled due to weather concerns, no funds were distributed. The hope is to use part of that carry-over balance for the symposium, a local event, rather than forwarding to other parts of our service structure, thereby allowing our PR subcommittee to have the freedom to stock up for this event as well as others in the way of table/booth set up items.

In discussions with the Zarrow team, there was some indication that an "early-bird" registration discount could be available in April, but the details had not been finalized.
