- RD TEAM –
 - The US Zones are developing a resource platform for fellowship development, PR, and related topics, while deciding whether to remain a resource or provide services. More info- <http://usa-na.org>
 - Future PSZF PR presentations may invite law, medical, nursing, police academy, and similar students in addition to professionals. We hope to use this idea when hosting the Feb 2027 PSZF. Our Zone agreed to contribute \$600 toward the PR luncheon at the Multi-Zonal Service Symposium in Wichita, KS, Oct 2-4, 2026, hosted by PSZF.  - Sponsorship Behind the Walls- after the tragic death of longtime OK Region NA member Rhonda B, a new Postal Coordinator was elected. The committee has not accessed its PO Box, but the coordinator will try to retrieve the keys in person. A guideline will have the facilitator hold spare keys. Open Positions- Co-Postal Coordinator, Co-Facilitator, and Liaison.
 - The Zone supports continuing three in-person and one virtual meeting per year, in lieu of returning to the two and two rotation used in the past, but asks the Regions to make the final decision. The next 3 in person meeting hosts will be OK Region, Best Little, and Iowa. OK Region will host with the GSA Feb 5-7, 2027 at Saint Grove Camp in Glencoe, OK.
 - CAR/CAT Collaboration- the Zone may collaborate with other Zones for future CAR/CAT discussions, likely starting fall 2028. Feedback will be sought from other Zones and Regions at MZSS in Oct.

 - **UNITY DAY VIRTUAL CELEBRATION**- Sept 5, 2026, starting at 1300 with two 90 min sessions, a 30 in break, and the Global Serenity Prayer at 1430. Focus is PR highlights and personal shares.
 - WCNA 39 Planning- WCNA 39 will be held in Dublin, Ireland, in July 2028. Agreements are in place; exact dates await signed contracts.
 - Update on IDTs and Literature- This cycle's IDTs are 1) Attracting/mentoring members, 2) Welcoming new members, and 3) Group/Area service, which will inform revisions began at the July Conference Participant meeting. Revised IP 21, Staying Clean in Isolation, is now available in the literature store!

- Audio lit. – the BT is free in 14 languages, and the Introductory Guide is available in English and Spanish. Next planned: Just For Today, first in English and Spanish, since audio is heavily used on inmate tablets.
- Participation Opportunities- World Services invites members to volunteer through the Focus Group Volunteer Form by selecting opportunities and sharing relevant experience/contact info. Examples include engaging younger or culturally diverse members and evaluating WCNA 39 speaker recordings. The form is at <http://na.org/projects>
- Exploring Revisions IP #1 Who, What, How and Why- Na groups have long requested more gender-inclusive readings, and 78% of 4,000 respondents to the 2026 CAR survey supported exploring gender-inclusive revisions. The 2026 WSC agreed to explore a revision draft of IP #1. Suggested changes include replacing “man or woman” with “person”, “men and women” with “people”, and adding “gender” to the “regardless of” statement, and replacing “wives, husbands, and children” with “families and loved ones”. Fellowship input will help determine next steps, and it is important to remember **we are only EXPLORING these changes**; no changes will occur unless approved by the Fellowship via the World Service Conference in 2029. Fellowship Development Projects and Updates:

- DOC Landline Updates: Many Oklahoma Department of Corrections (DOC) offices have transitioned from landlines to state cell phone, causing disconnected numbers on contact registries. FD is systematically updating contact sheets and dispatching IP rack refills and schedule QR code decals.
- WORLD UNITY DAY- Sept 5, 2026. An international Zoom speaker feed with Portuguese and Spanish translation will be made available.
- Archive Storage Reorganization: the Archivist is coordinating with event chairs to pack and consolidate regional historic archives and event inventory into newly approved heavy-duty totes.

● General Service Assembly:

- GSA is hosting the PSZF in Feb 5-7, 2027. Saint's Grove Campground.
 - One representative per group and OK Region trusted servants admitted at no charge; regular member pricing adjusted by \$5-10; outside zonal attendees pay \$70-80. Includes a Friday newcomer panel and four Saturday IDT workshops presented by PSZF participants.

- **Clean and Crazy Campout:**

- Successfully concluded with 128 registered attendees and approx.. 130 people attended the Sat night speaker mtg.
- Event financial accounting reflected total income of \$13,073.40 against expenses of \$9,652.12, generating a net profit of \$3,421.28 (pre-tax)
- The 2027 permit and campsite reservations have been approved and secured with OK Parks Administration (\$3,100)
- Mark M was unanimously elected as 2027 Clean and Crazy Chair.

- **Fall Spiritual Retreat:**

- Birthday Bash Fundraiser was had on Aug 15.
- Pre-order Merch- flannel shirts, sweatpants, and blankets are available for pre-order through Oct. 15, 2026

- **OK Region Convention of Narcotics Anonymous (OKRCNA):**

- "Hope Lives Here" is the theme
- Theme artwork features the downtown Oklahoma City skyline
- Pre-convention merch has been updated to regular crewneck sweatshirts.

New Business: Motions, Discussions, Etc.

- **MOTION TAKE TO HOMEGROUPS** - OKNA, Inc. Bylaws Proposal (For Area/Group Conscience)
 - **Proposal:** OKRSC is asking for approval to update the OKNA, Inc. (our 501©(3) nonprofit entity) bylaws to extend term limits for Board officer positions (Secretary, Treasurer, President, etc.)
 - **Intent:** When OKNA, Inc. board was first established position terms were set to a strict 3-year limit with no option to serve longer. This was a default template provided by legal counsel during incorporation and does not provide the flexibility needed for service within the OK Region. The proposal extends the term limit to 5 years, with the ability to extend further upon Board approval. This ensures experienced servants (such as the Regional Treasurer) can continue holding the corporate responsibilities when no replacements are available.

Open Service Positions: Position, Requirements, etc. – TAKE TO HOME GROUPS

- Co-Facilitator- 2 year term, 5 year clean time, assists Facilitator; transitions to Facilitator in year 2.
- Co-Treasurer- 2 year term, 5 year clean time; financial ledgers, tax filings, banking co-signer, 501©(3) board.
- Alternate Delegate 2 (A2D2)- 3 year term, 5 year clean time; Delegate team support, attends WSC/PSZF/MZSS; GSA committee.
- Fellowship Development Coordinator (FD)- 2 year term, 4 year clean time; Facilitates FD, coordinates workshops and \$500 annual area projects.
- Web Contact- 2 year term, 5 year clean time; Website upkeep, domain/email admin, meeting list updates
- Probation & Parole IP Rack Coordinator- 2 year term, 2 year clean time; restocks and manages DOC/Probation literature racks statewide.
- OKNA, Inc. Board Members (2 vacancies)- Board Term, Prior RSC experience; oversees regional 501©93) nonprofit corporate compliance.
